TYPICAL PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE INSPECTIONS INCLUDE:

- Visual inspection and rating of the overall health and performance of your current system
- System air volume measurements and overall performance ratings
- Monitoring of system air volume, static and velocity pressure, filter pressure, and current test data
- Inspection of pulse valves, solenoid valves, compressed air pressure, door seal integrity, and timer settings
- Documentation of fan inlet static and RPM, as well as inspection of fans, housings, bearings, and drives
- Inspection of collector(s) discharge hopper, augers, and rotary valves
- Documentation of pressure drop across all filters
- Inspection pressure gauges for proper function
- Ultraviolet leak detection of filter media
